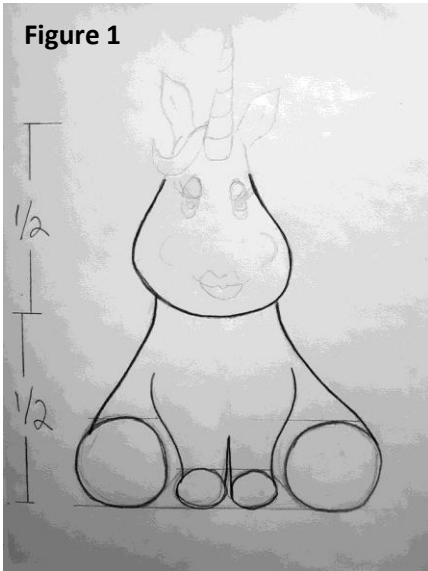


Fashionista Sassy Unicorn



Sassy Unicorn is a charming mythical creature with lots of fashion creativity. She wants to come alive in your sketchbook. Follow these step by step drawing instructions to learn how to bring your own Fashionista Sassy Unicorn to life.

What you will need:

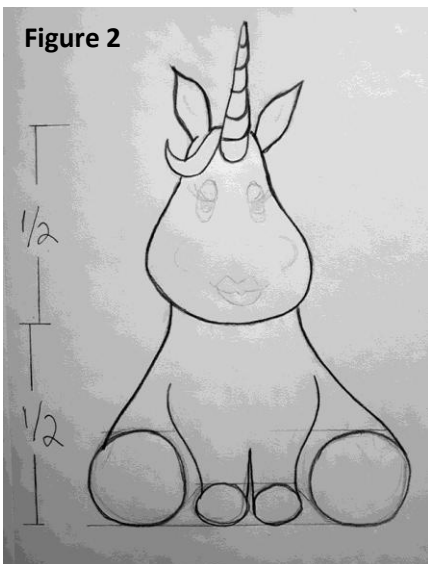
- Sketchbook paper or copy paper
- Pencil, eraser, ruler
- Black coloured pencil or black marker
- Coloured pencils or markers
- Newspaper or plastic tablecloth for working area

First Steps

Anytime you are unsure of what to do, study the samples provided.

Create a base line near the bottom of your paper by lightly drawing a horizontal line in pencil. Use your ruler to make sure it's straight.

At each end of the base line, draw a circle. Between the two circles, draw two smaller circles. These circles will be Sassy's front and back feet. After you have drawn the circles, draw two curved lines to form the outer part of the front legs. Then draw two short lines for the inner legs. See figure 1.

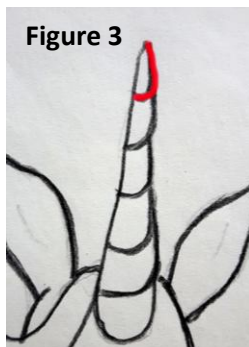

The unicorn's head is the shape of a pear. When drawing Sassy's body and head, note that they are the same length. Half the length of your drawing should be Sassy's head and the bottom half should be her body. See figure 2.

Most drawings have shapes. Here her ears look like pointed leaves or triangles. The hair can be shaped like the letter 'J'. The horn is a long triangle. Now draw each component: ears, hair and horn. It does not have to be perfect; anything you draw will be part of the character.

To add more shape to the horn, draw the letter 'C' backwards from the tip of the horn to the head. Do this a few times from top to bottom. See the sample in red on Figure 3.

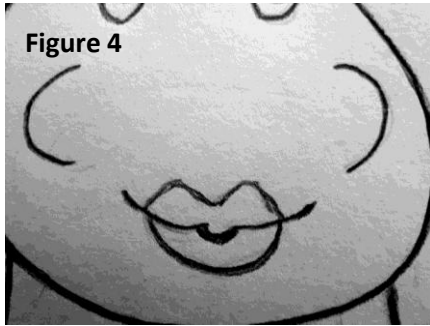

Final Steps

Let's draw the lips next. See figure 4. Sassy has model-like lips. The top of the lips is an upside down 'W' while the bottom is a sideways 'C'. Now draw two 'Cs' for her nose. It looks like her cheeks, but remember a unicorn has a long nose like a horse that is part of the head.

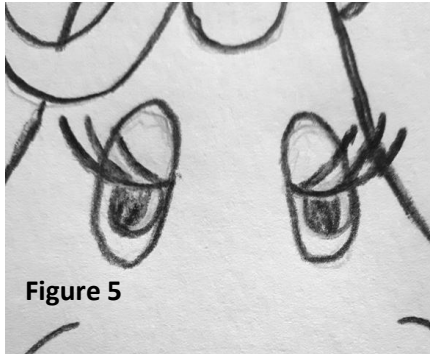

Let's move on to drawing the eyes. Sassy has cow-like eyes, very big and droopy with long eyelashes. The outer eyes have the shape of an egg with a curved line in the middle of the eye.

Below this line draw a half circle for the pupil and fill in. Don't forget to add long curved lines for the eyelashes.

What makes a unicorn a unicorn and not a horse? Besides the horn a unicorn needs? Wings! Since Sassy Unicorn is relaxing, her wings will be in a down position and very easy to draw.

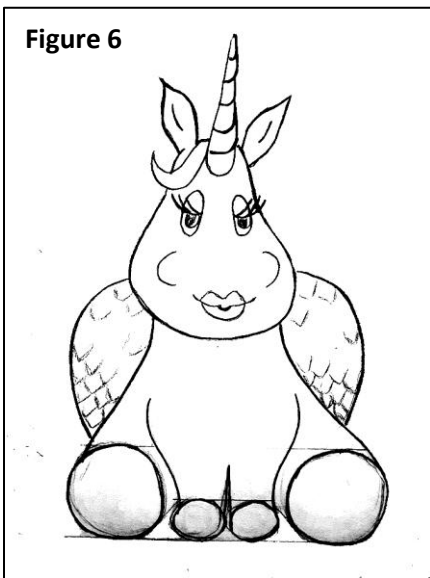

The wings are half circles with a few 'Vs' drawn on them. You don't have to fill up the whole wing with 'Vs' just a few to each side to give the illusion of feathers. Once you have finished drawing the unicorn in pencil, outline your drawing in black coloured pencil or a black marker. Outlining your drawing gives it definition and makes colours stand out.

Once you have outlined the unicorn you are your ready to colour! Dress up Sassy with your imagination. Use Coloured pencils or markers.
